Summary:The Board will hold a second reading, and consider possible adoption of an Ordinance adjusting the Fire Prevention Fee Schedule to recover actual costs, and add additional categories to the schedule to reflect the actual tasks and activities of the Fire Prevention Office.

Background:At it's Regular Meeting on April 14th, 2020, the Board heard the first reading of the Ordinance and approved it to move forward to a second reading for possible adoption.

Discussion:The Fire Prevention Fees in the Fire District have not been adjusted since 2004. Not only does the amount currently collected not cover the costs of the activities and tasks, the schedule of fees does not cover the many tasks and activities of the Fire Prevention Office. Adjusting the Fee Schedule will allow the District to come closer to full cost recovery for these services. This schedule was coordinated with the City of Ukiah with the vision of a uniform fee schedule for the the entire area served by the Fire Authority. It has since been adopted and enacted by the City Council at their May 20th, 2020 meeting.

Attachment 1 shows the current fee schedule that was adopted in 2004, while Attachment 2 shows the revised Ordinance and proposed fee schedule.

Attachment 4 shows the comparable jurisdictions we utilized in drafting the proposed fees, with Attachment 5 showing a comparison of our proposed fees with those jurisdictions.

Section 4: COST RECOVERY OF SERVICES (cont.)

- (c) **The following services will be billed using fee schedule (B) to anyone receiving those services:**

Plan Review/Inspections Fees (when a plan review and/or fire inspections are requested, or required by state or local ordinance.) These fees will be charged for actual office time, field inspection time and phone consultation time. When a person fails to cancel a requested inspection prior to the time of the inspection, one hour shall be charged.

Third and subsequent company fire prevention re-inspections when it is necessary as a result of outstanding code violations not corrected, one hour shall be charged.

For building plan review, an estimated hourly fee will be due prior to a building permit being issued. The estimated hourly fee is determined by the size of the project. Square footage calculations are computed on total floor area, which includes all floors, heated and unheated, porches, and garages.

Plan Review/Inspection Fees \$50.00 per hour

hourly rates will be billed at a minimum one hour and subsequent time rounded to the nearest 1/2 hour.

Estimated hourly fee based on size of project at .10 per square ft. rounded to nearest \$50.

ORDINANCE 2020-

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE UKIAH VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT
ADJUSTING FIRE PREVENTION FEE SCHEDULE**

The Board of Directors of the Ukiah Valley Fire District ordains as follows:

Section 1: AUTHORIZATION AND PURPOSE

This ordinance to revise a schedule of fees is adopted pursuant to Section 13916 of the Health and Safety Code which provides that the District may charge a fee to cover the cost of any service which the District provides or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which the fee is charged. This ordinance rescinds any other Fee Schedule Ordinance or Resolution.

Section 2: APPLICABILITY

Pursuant to the California Health and Safety Code and California Fire Code, the Ukiah Valley Fire District is charged with the enforcement of adopted development regulations and inspections of certain properties and the permitting for occupancy of certain buildings.

Section 3: VALIDITY

If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance shall for any reason be declared invalid, such holding or holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. It is the intent of the Board of Directors that it would have passed all other portions of this Ordinance independent of the elimination here from of any such portion as may be declared invalid.

Section 5: OTHER INFORMATION

The fees imposed by said Fee Schedule must be paid by the applicant for any permit in connection with which any covered plan check or inspection is requested or required before the service is provided.

When any covered inspection is conducted for fire safety purposes and not at the request of the permit applicant, property owner, tenant, or other person occupying the property, or where collecting the fee in advance is for any other reason impractical or not in the interest of preserving fire safety, the City shall collect the fee at the earliest opportunity and the Finance Department and City Attorney are authorized to take all actions, including legal action, they deem necessary to collect said fees. The City's ordinances imposing interest and authorizing the City to recover its attorney's fees shall apply to such collection efforts. If an applicant commences work requiring a permit for which a covered inspection or plan check is required before submitting his or her application, the fees set forth in the Fee Schedule shall be doubled for all covered services provided in connection with that permit application.

Section 6: EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its adoption and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) day from passage thereof, shall be published twice in the local area newspaper of general circulation in the County of Mendocino, State of California, with the names of the members of the Board of Directors voting for and against the same.

Summary: The Fire District Board will consider approving the purchase of a self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) system from Allstar Fire Equipment in the Amount of \$346,965.46, Utilizing a Municipal Lease Agreement.

Background: SCBA is equipment worn by firefighters to provide breathable air in situations where there is immediate risk to life or health from the air they breathe. They are self-contained, as they do not depend on a remote supply. The SCBA system consists of a high-pressure tank, a pressure regulator, and facemask – all connected together by a carrying harness.

The Fire Authority's SCBA System needs replacement, due to multiple issues:

1. Approximately half of their current units are 4500 psi models, and the other half 3000 psi models, which are not interchangeable. This is because the City and the Fire District had purchased different models prior to combining services.
2. The 3000 psi bottles are at the end of their 15-year lifespan, and are no longer made, which will make half of their units soon completely obsolete – causing a huge impact on how they can safely respond to, and combat, fires.
3. The manufacturer of the current units no longer makes replacement parts. Some aftermarket parts are available, but are at a considerably higher cost.
4. Every year more units fail the annually required flow testing, or their Integrated Control Module (ICM) goes bad.

5. As the number of serviceable units continue to dwindle, the Fire Authority's level of service needs adjustment, to protect the health and safety of their staff.

6. Grant funding has been sought unsuccessfully.

Discussion: Staff received quotes for two of the only National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) SCBA manufacturers. Please refer to Attachment 1 for a copy of the quotes. Allstar Fire Equipment, the authorized reseller of the Scott SCBA system, provided the lowest price, in the amount of \$346,965.46. This purchase will be a shared expense between City Fire and the Fire District.

In order to complete this transaction at this time, it is Staff's recommendation to finance the purchase, utilizing the City's line of credit with Umpqua Bank. The financing agreement went to the City Council on June 3rd, and was subsequently approved, along with the City's portion of the equipment purchase. This agreement will be for 10 years at an interest rate of 2.39%, with semi-annual payments of \$19,622.20.

Since it is a City lease agreement, the initial financing will run through Fund 253 (City Prop 172 funds), with the debt service payments made equally out of both the City and Fire District's (Fund 916) Prop 172 funds. The first payment will not be due until January 1, 2021.

Recommended Action: Approve the purchase of a self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) system from Allstar Fire Equipment in the amount of \$346,965.46.
